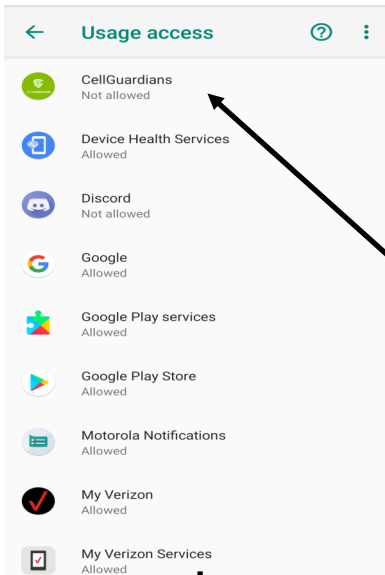
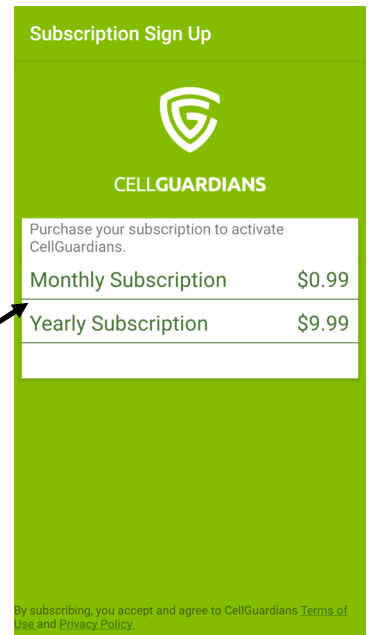
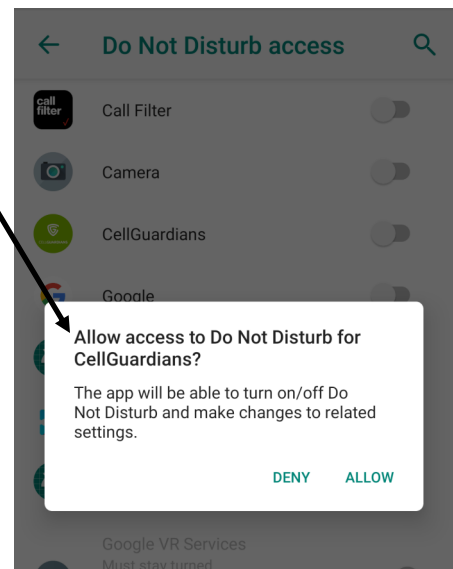
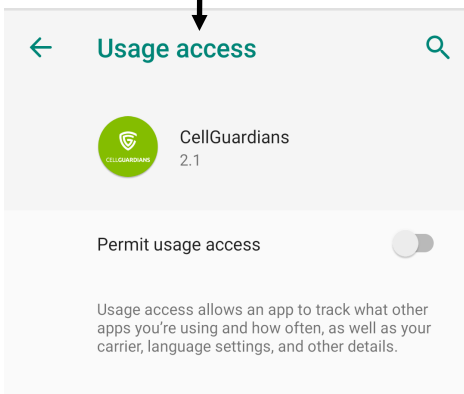
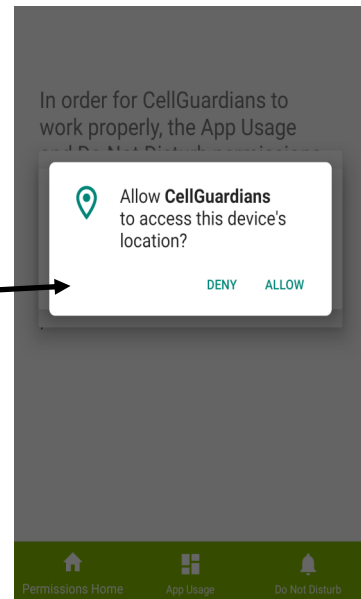


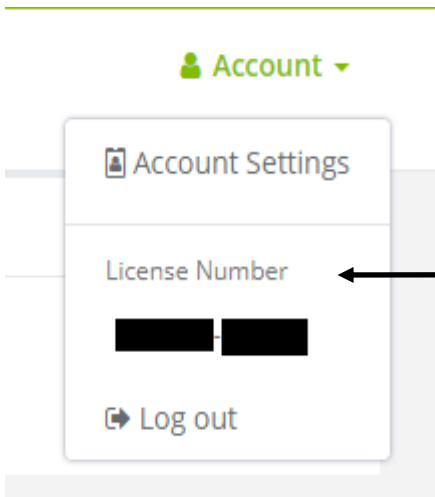
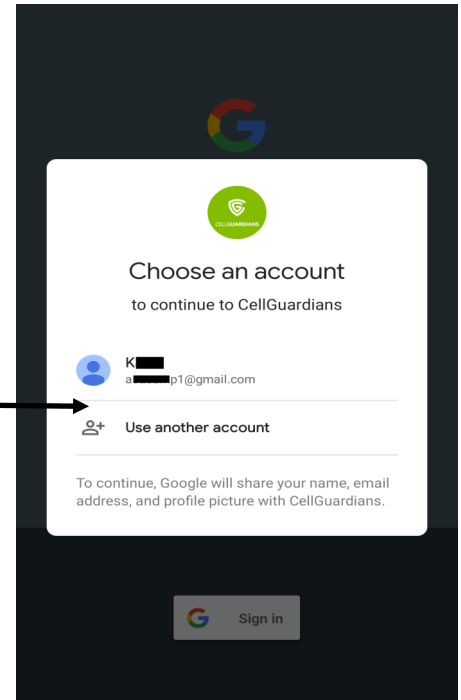
Step 1: Go to the Google Play Store on your Android device and search for CellGuardians. The app should be the first result. Select the app to install it. Once installed, tap the open button. The Subscription Sign Up page for CellGuardians will appear. Choose a monthly or yearly subscription and select a payment method to continue.



Step 2: The next screen will ask about allowing different Android apps permissions. The first is location which can be Deny or Allow. Then is Usage Access which prompts the user to the system settings screen to permit usage access. Finally when prompted, the user will need to allow access to Do Not Disturb by selecting Allow.



Step 3: The user will be prompted to sign in using a Google account. The user can choose a currently logged in account or a different account.



From the Guardian dashboard, click account on the top right of the screen to view the *License Number*.

Step 4: Once signed in to Google, the user will need to access the Guardian's *license number* which can be found in the original Guardian sign up email or in the Account Settings accessible in the Guardian's account. Enter the phone number and use the *license number* to sync to the Guardian's account.
